Spanning 17 hectares, 14.5 under vine, Domaine Guiberteau's vineyards are perfectly balanced with 7.5 hectares of premium Chenin Blanc and 7 hectares of exceptional Cabernet Franc. Strategically located across the prestigious communes of Brézé, Montreuil-Bellay, Épiéds, and Saint-Just-sur-Dive, the estate benefits from some of the Loire Valley's most sought-after terroirs. The standout Brézé vineyard is celebrated for its superior quality, thanks to its unique tuffeau limestone soils. Renowned for excellent drainage and rich mineral content, these soils impart a signature flinty elegance and complexity to the wines — a true hallmark of Domaine Guiberteau's distinguished portfolio.
