Producer Profile

Equipo Navazos is a group of friends who have united over a shared passion for the treasures of Jerez, Sanlúcar, El Puerto and Montilla.

Working with local producers to identify high quality butts of sherry with finesse and complexity which they then bottle and offer in very limited amounts. As well as producing sherry, Equipo Navazos has collaborated with other winemakers including Dirk Niepoort and Sergi Colet to develop some intriguing and characterful wines from Jerez and sparkling wines from Penèdes.

Viticulture

The best "color" wine was obtained in the past from the slow fermentation of a blend of musts of Palomino Fino and arrope. Many color wines were traditionally used to add colour to the oloroso wines but practice all but disappeared around 1960/ 1970.

Tasting Note

Only 1100 bottles of this fantastic, very old and extremely rare wine are made, around 80 years old, although no one knows for sure. A pitch black colour that stains the glass. Powerful notes of dried fruit, liquorice, caramel and coffee. Concentrated and persistent, almost aggressive. A bit like marmite, You either love it or hate it!
