VITICULTURE

Schlossberg was the first vineyard in Alsace to be declared a Grand Cru. The south facing granite hill that the vineyard sits on is cooled by the night time breezes as air is moved through the narrow valley. The stony soils also make for good drainage.

WINEMAKING

Fermentation in stainless steel for a few months as well as lees ageing.

TASTINGNOTE

This Grand Cru Schlossberg Riesling is refreshing and mouthwatering, offering anise, melon, grapefruit and salinity as well as the typical petrol like aromas. Lovely length and so fresh!
